Old Business:

Kelly proposed purchasing a refrigerator and stocking it with drinks and accepting payment in the same way coffee is paid for.
 - Motion passed to spend up to 800\$ on refurbished machine.

5. Kelly made a motion to have an outside vendor supply a drink vending machine at no cost to the group. Diane seconded.
 - Motion was withdrawn by Kelly
